QUALIFYING CRITERIA

- Applicants must be South African citizens, residing in the Western Cape or Northern Cape
- Applicants must have access to their own computer, with an uninterrupted data connection
- Applicants must be involved in a farming operation, past graduates of the Academy or Grade 12 graduates interested in a career in agriculture
- Applicants must be available to attend all practical contact sessions, as well as online classes
